

SB 90 (Baxley) Vote-by-Mail Ballots, will be heard Tuesday Feb. 16 at 12:30 pm ET (11:30 am CT) in the Senate Ethics and Elections Committee. This bill intends to limit the duration of vote-by-mail (VBM) requests to all elections within the calendar year of request. Current law allows for one request to extend through the second calendar year of a regularly scheduled general election.

Make no mistake--this is a voter suppression bill.

- Despite the fact that Gov. DeSantis and the Florida GOP have bragged about how Florida is the election model for other states to follow, they are outraged because Democrats reversed the Republican lead in VBM ballots in the November 2020 election.
- Currently, requesting a VBM ballot is neither intuitive nor easy. This bill would place additional administrative roadblocks in front of voters who want--and need--to vote this way in every election.
- This bill would significantly increase the time, effort and our taxpayer dollars spent by Florida's Supervisor of Elections offices to register citizens for VBM every year.
- The Florida Legislature should be expanding the opportunities to vote, not suppressing those opportunities.
